Torremolinos

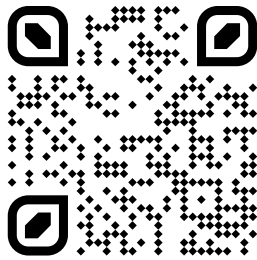
